

# The Sneaker Challenge

List the materials you will need to make your sneaker. \*

cardboard box, plastic bag, marker, scissors, screwdriver, electric tape, measuring tape.

List the steps you use to make your sneaker. Number the steps. \*

1. Put my foot inside the box to measure.
  2. Cut off the tops of the sides. Cut box on the seams all sides.
  3. Folded the sides over to fit my foot.
  4. Cut a strip all the way around a plastic bag for the shoe string.
  5. Made a mark for holes for the laces. (four on each side- 3 cm. apart.)
  6. Punched the holes.
  7. Pushed the "shoe string" the holes.
  8. Taped the ends with the electric tape. (Use the rest of the bag to cushion the inside of the shoe.
  9. Trimmed the excess cardboard. (I will use it for decoration on the finished shoe.) Taped the sides together.
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Explain how repurposing or recycling these items will help the environment. \*

I get a lot of shipping boxes and I have several plastic bags. The box and the bag won't end up in a landfill.

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
